## Boy Scout Troop 783

Dear Prospective Scouts and Parents,

Thank you for considering Troop 783. The BSA Joining Requirements require that a boy to be an Arrow of Light recipient OR in Grade 6 or higher OR 11 years of age to be eligible to join a Boy Scout Troop.

All the necessary forms for registration are available on the troop's website.

Go to [www.troop783.com](http://www.troop783.com) and click "HERE," for the link to Troop 783's BSA Youth and Adult Online Application and other registration documents and information.

***Please note that the BSA Online Application will request a credit card. This will only be charged if the applicant is completely new to scouting. If the scout or adult is already registered with BSA, the applicant will not be charged as long as a Membership ID or Unit Number is provided.***

The following items are required for registration:

1. Accompany your scout to a Troop 783 meeting and/or event
2. BSA Youth Application: click BSA Online Youth Application and follow the instructions
3. BSA Adult Application: click BSA Online Adult Volunteer Application and follow the instructions

**Each scout is required to have at least one parent registered with the troop**

**Each adult application must be accompanied by:**

- i. Certificate of Completion for Youth Protection Online Course
  - ii. Certificate of Completion for Hazardous Weather Online Course

  6. Troop 783 Permission Slip to attend Troop Meetings
  7. Troop Policy and Procedure Signature Pages
    - a. The Policies and Procedures Agreement is the last page of the T783 Policies and Procedures Document available via a link at [www.troop783.com/JoiningTheTroop](http://www.troop783.com/JoiningTheTroop) and a link on the Troop 783 Website navigation sidebar.
    - b. Both scout and parents must sign this page
    - c. Read and sign the Behavioral addendum, the second to last page of the policies and procedures.
  8. Check made payable to Troop 783 for \$75.00 if a current Webelo or \$100 if new to scouting.
    - a. This fee includes: a troop t-shirt, troop neckerchief, 5 tickets to the Scout Pancake Breakfast, Scout and Adult registration, Boys Life Magazine, merit badges and awards

Once the troop registrar has received your completed packet, your application will be brought before the Parents' Committee at their next regularly scheduled meeting for approval.
