

Behavioral Addendum

If the Troop 783 Scoutmaster determines that the following provisions apply to the scout, then the parent or guardian of the scout agrees to abide by the following:

Mandatory and ongoing provisions

1. A parent (or otherwise qualified adult) will shadow the scout at all times without exception. This will be the case at meetings, events and on trips.
2. The parents or guardian of the scout and the Scoutmaster shall confer on a regular basis to determine what events and activities may be suitable for the scout to participate in. The decision as to the approved events and activities, and any conditions or limitations surrounding such events and activities, shall be made by the Scoutmaster in his sole absolute discretion. The scout can only participate in such approved events and activities with the requisite supervision described above in the preceding bullet point. These activities and events include but are not limited to activities that include shooting, knives and fire.
3. The mandatory and ongoing provisions laid out in this document will remain in force even after the provisional period described below has successfully ended. The Scoutmaster will determine if and when the mandatory and ongoing provisions can be lifted.

Temporary provisions

1. The scout is provisionally accepted into the troop. The provisional period will last for six months. Failure to abide by the provisions laid out in this agreement at any point during the six months will result the scout forfeiting membership in the troop. Any incident deemed by the Scoutmaster to be unsafe to the scout and others at any point during the six months will result in the scout forfeiting membership in the troop.
